02 - RJ45 connector

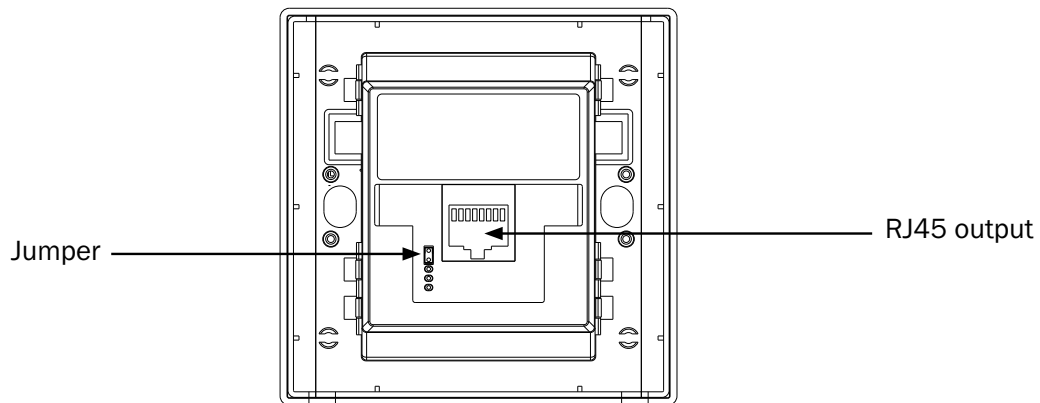

Setup:

The Cygnus WP3 is to be used with the Cygnus QR (ELUM258) to trigger programs.

1. Connect the wall plate to the Cygnus QR (ELUM258) via an RJ45 cable (max. length 25m).
2. Install the wall panel in two ways, with or without the jumper.
 - **With the jumper:** Set the Cygnus QR (ELUM258) to “**TOGGLE_TR**”.
 - **Without the jumper:** Set the Cygnus QR (ELUM258) to “**NO_TR**”

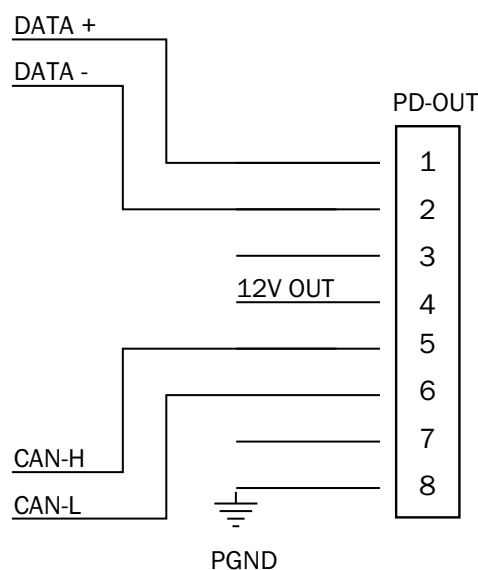
LED indicators:

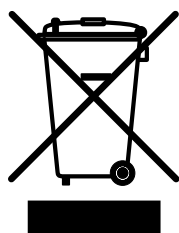
The Cygnus WP3 is fitted with six backlit playback buttons. Their functions are detailed below.

POWER – The LED numbers on the buttons will illuminate to indicate that the unit is receiving power.

TRIGGER – The LED number will flash white when a trigger is active. The LED will remain off when no trigger is present.
